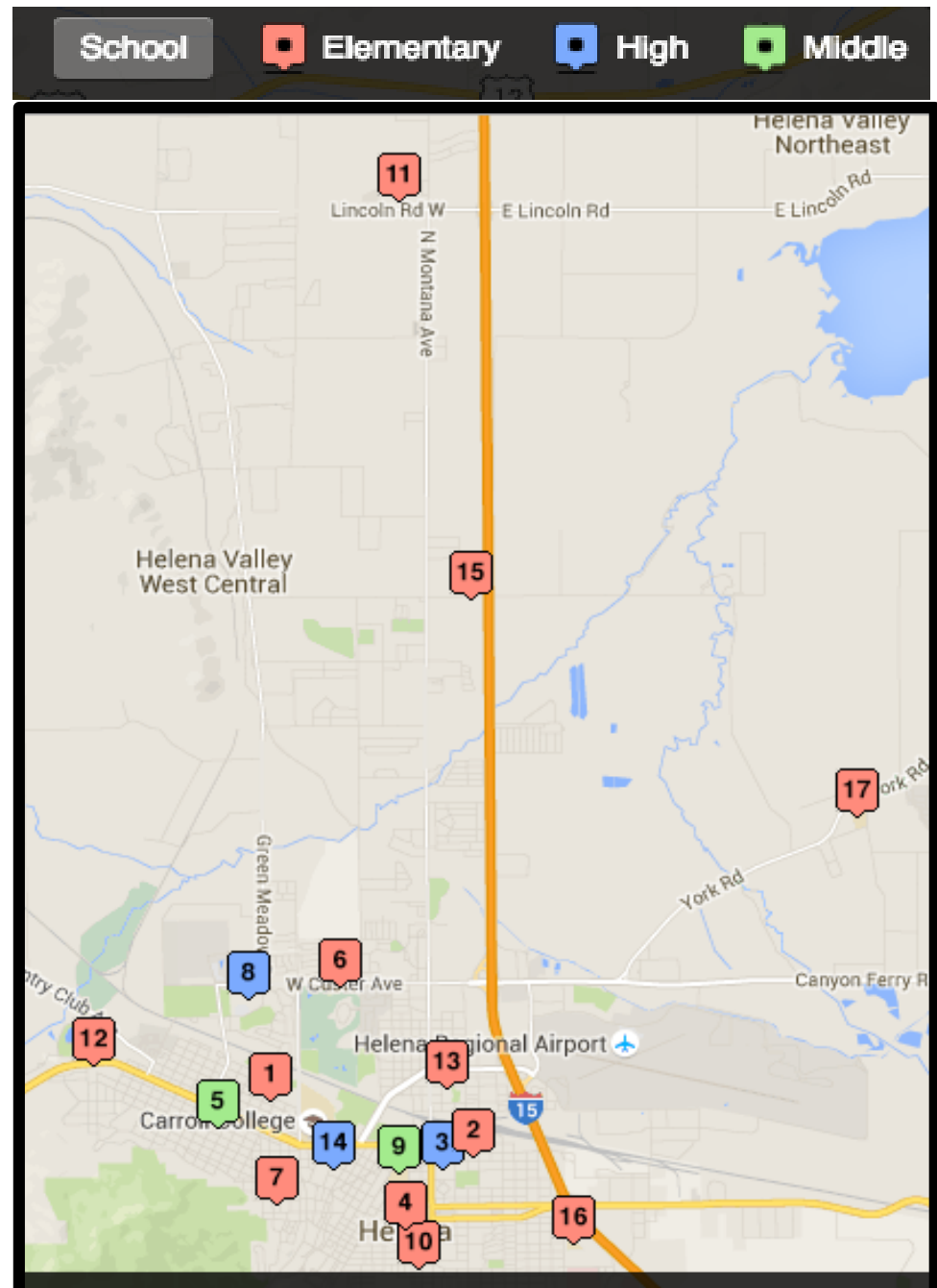


Where are our Schools and when were they Built?

4. **Central Elementary School:** Built: 1914, Addition: 1921 **OLDEST**; *currently closed*
5. **C.R Anderson Middle School:** Built: 1959, Additions: 1965, 1992, Modular: prior to 1994
6. **Four Georgians Elementary School:** Built: 1977 **NEWEST**
7. **Hawthorne Elementary School:** Built: 192/Repair: 1937 Modular: 1989
8. **Capital High School:** Built: 1964, Additions: 1972, 1981, 1983, 1998
9. **Helena Middle School:** Built: 1935, Additions: 1994
10. **Jefferson Elementary School:** Built: 1948, Additions: 1977, 2013
11. **Jim Darcy Elementary School:** Built: 1965, Additions: 1969, 1977, Modular: 2002, 2013, 2014, 2015, Annexed: 1985
12. **Kessler Elementary School:** (Built: 1935, Additions: 1948, 1956, 1958, 1967, 1990) Annexed 1995
13. **Lincoln School/Central-Linc. Elementary School:** Built: 1946 Updates: 1956, 1960, Modular 2013
14. **Project Alternative Learning/Front Street Learning Center:** Built: 1957 as grocery store, Converted 1990, Updates: 2013
15. **Rossiter Elementary School:** Built: 1966, Additions: 1977, Modular: Prior to 2001
16. **Smith Elementary School:** Built: 1966, Additions: 1977
17. **Warren Elementary School:** Built: 1968, Additions: 1977, 1993, Modular: 2012, Annexed 1985

How many Students attend Special Programs offered by the District?

Special Education Pre-School: An additional 97 pre-k students attend school at the Ray Bjork Learning Center.

Montessori: 171 students (grades 1-5) are enrolled in the program.
Central = 60; Smith = 56; and Broadwater = 55

Project Alternative Learning (PAL): 60 students participate in a high school program located at the Front Street Learning Center.

Access to Success: Ninety-three students attend school on the Helena College campus to obtain a high school diploma.

ExploreSchool -- 51 home-school students attend a program at Exploration Works and are enrolled in the district on a part-time basis.
